GEOMETRIC FIGURES

There are three types of geometric figure: one-, two-, and three-dimensional.

one-dimensional figure

A one-dimensional figure is a figure that only has length. You can only measure one trait of this type of figure – how long it is.

two-dimensional figure

A **two-dimensional figure** has length and width. You can measure two traits of this type of figure – how **long** it is and how **wide** it is.

three-dimensional figure

A three-dimensional figure is a figure that has length, width, and height. You can measure three traits of this type of figure – how long it is, how wide it is, and how tall it is.
